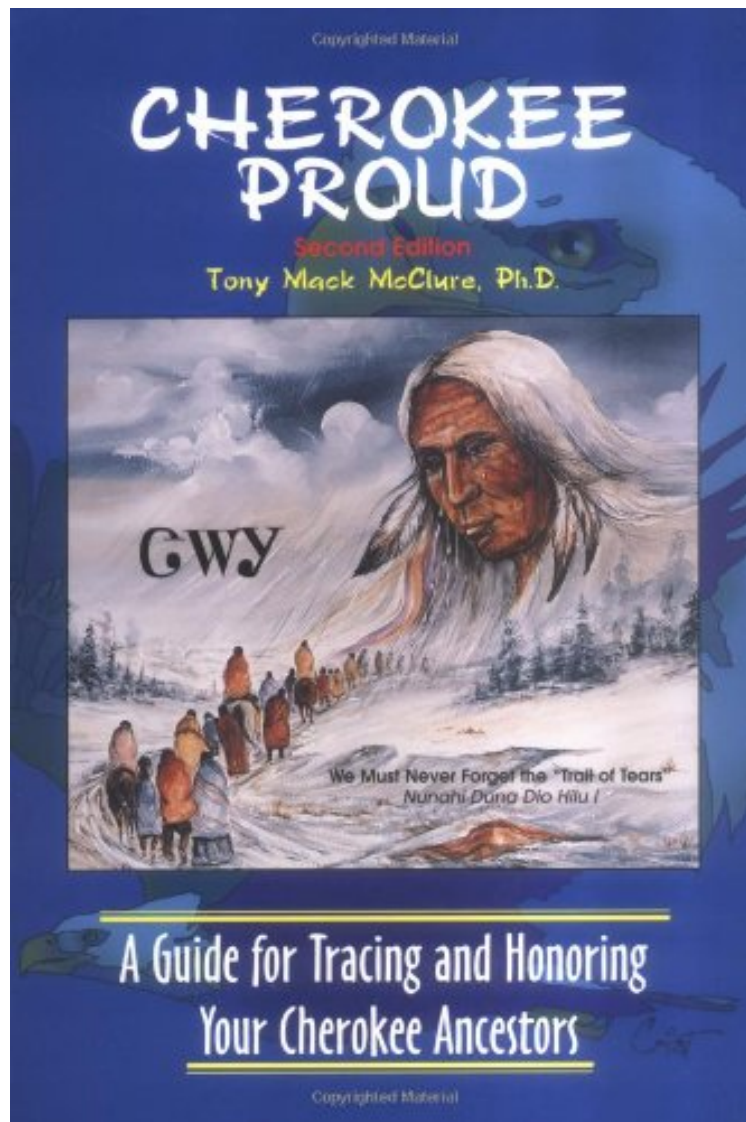

This confirms verbal history on Cherokee as well as and natives ancestors along the Virginia coast whom interacted with the lost colony.
