Bloomsbury is not a common publishing house on my shelf. This edition was printed and bound in India. It was glued, which would be fine. Most books are these days. But the issue is that the blue dripped onto the interior of the back cover and so when it opened the binding ripped away

the paper of the inside back cover. And so my conclusion is there is no oversight of quality. I will not be surprised to find other problems, and seeing it is part of a massive series, I will be slow to order others in the set. As flaws go, it is not probably worth shipping back and waiting another four days to read the book, but were I buying this in a store I would pass it over for another copy or a different book.
