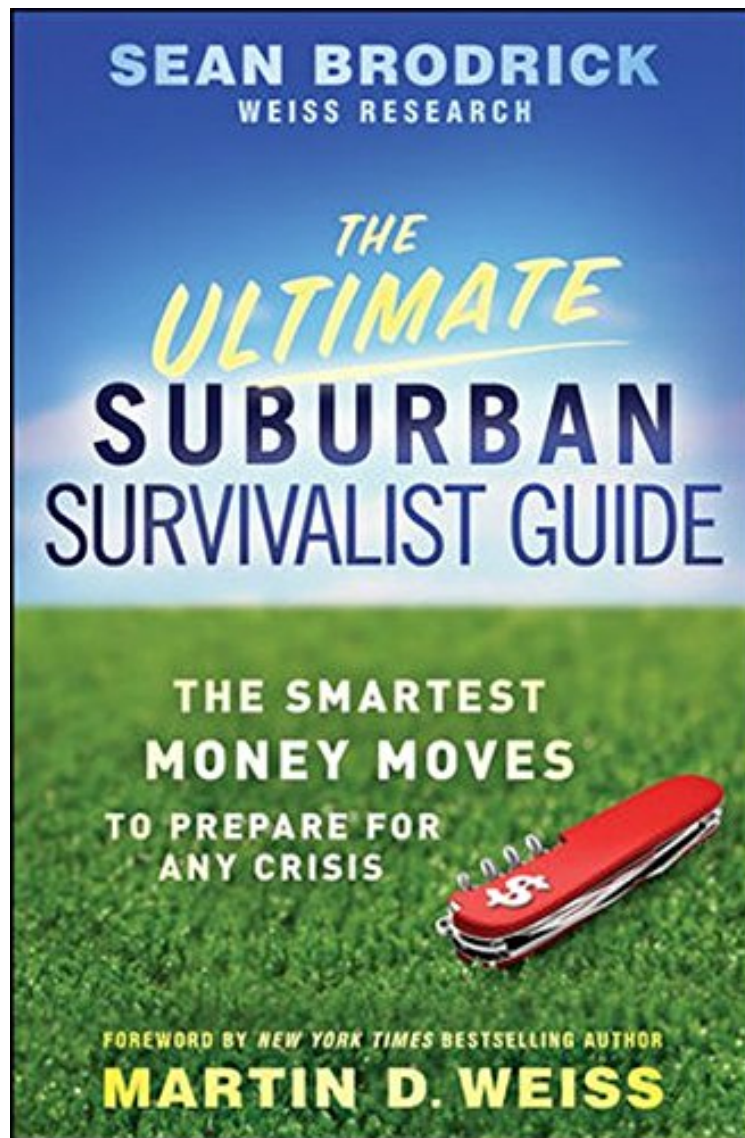

I don't know but Sean Brodrick somehow managed to pull it off. This book was not only well researched and well written, it was actually fun to read! The Ultimate Suburban Survivalist lays out in simple terms a comprehensive list of possible disaster scenarios (from common house fire to entire cities running dry,) and then explains what we can all do to not only prepare for them but, in some cases, even make a profit from the industries growing up to help deal with these problems. Sean covers the five basic areas of survival preparedness--food, water, medicine, money, and protection--and applies them to the real life environment that the majority of us are actually living in, the urban/suburban one. He even covers an area that I hadn't seriously considered before--how to prepare for a world where internet access could become more erratic and restricted due to energy shortages. (I'm starting to build my own library on thumb drives now.) One of the most valuable things about this book for me was its upbeat tone.
