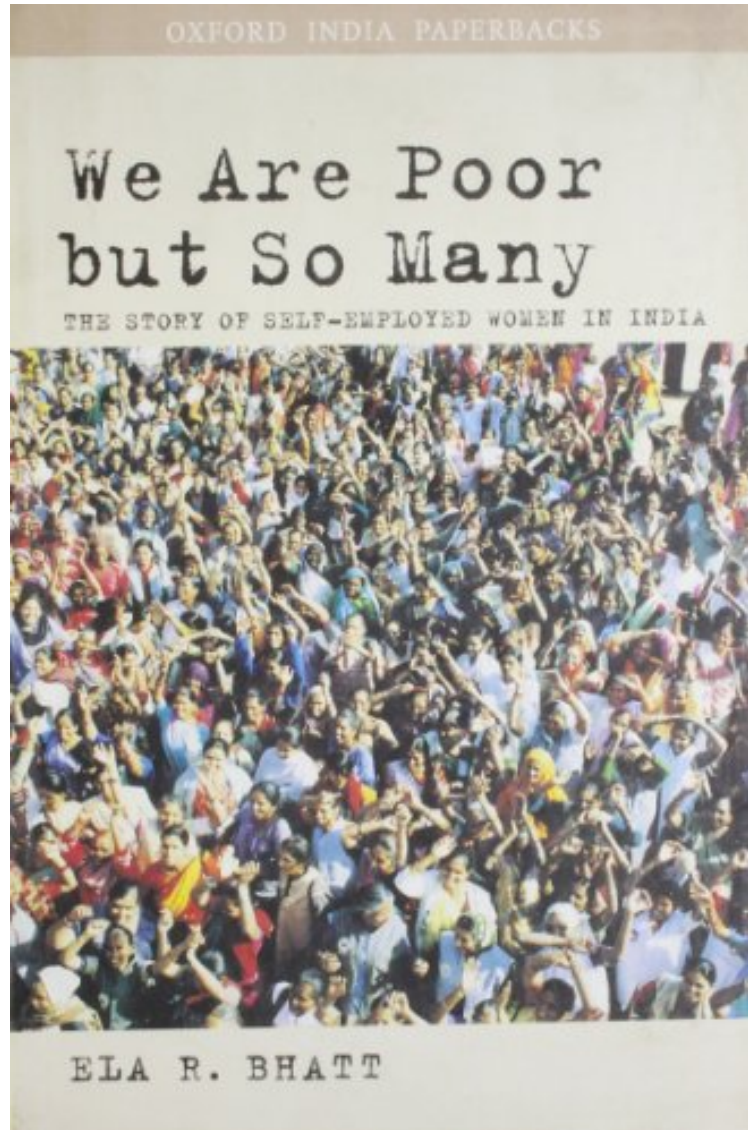

But the author came in and told them that if they only make 11 cents a day, if they are just able to deposit 1 cent into an account at a bank she helped them make, then the 1 cent would earn credit, and it really worked for them...
